

Building in Navitas Core Moodle

Learning and Teaching Services

Duration: 4 weeks

Mode(s) of delivery: Online

Live Sessions: Throughout the course, there will be weekly live sessions which will be recorded for those who are unable to attend.

Workload: 12 hours over a 4-week period

Introduction

This four week course gives content creators and editors the opportunity to work in a course sandbox developing resources and activities which they will showcase at the end. Participants will also have the opportunity to engage and collaborate with others throughout the course. Participants will use a range of learning technologies during the course, which will give them the experience and capability to apply these technologies to their own online teaching contexts. The course focuses on the pedagogical and design aspects of using particular technologies in teaching, while providing a number of resources that will assist with 'how to' guidance. The course features structured, paced and easy to understand content, optional live sessions each week, activity-based learning where participants use their learnings to create or improve their own courses and peer-assessment activity.

At the conclusion of the course, participants who have met specified requirements will receive a **Certificate of Completion**.

Learning Outcomes

On successful completion of this course, participants will be able to:

- Describe a range of tools from the three topics of course design: creating content, communicating and assessment
- Build an activity in the sandbox provided from each of the topics
- Showcase one activity for peer review and feedback, and provide feedback to others
- Reflect on design based feedback and plan strategies for implementation in own course
- Engage in, and contribute to a shared community of practice

Learning and Teaching Process

Participants will use a range of learning technologies during the course, which will be facilitated within Navitas Core Moodle as well as Zoom (for live sessions). Participants are required to have regular access to the Internet. A webcam and headset microphone is also required for live sessions.

Participants

The course is aimed at teaching and related staff who are new to teaching online or blended environments, or, experienced teaching staff who would like to improve the effectiveness of their existing online teaching practice. The course is a professional development activity available to all staff within Navitas.

Weekly Study Pattern

Participants are expected to commit a minimum of 12 hours over the 4-week period. During the course, participants will engage in individual and group activities which will include discussions, submitting material for feedback and providing feedback to other participants.

It is expected that participants will be actively engaging in activities each week of the course.

Professional Development Framework

Building in Navitas Core Moodle, is a course to gain experience and capability to apply learning technologies to their own online teaching contexts.
